

NEW ROUNDABOUT TECHNICAL COMMITTEE FORMING

The Illinois Section is about to form a technical committee on roundabouts to:

- Research and develop resources for professional development, with seminars and preparation of technical reports.
- > Disseminate information through meetings, flyers, brochures and other means.

Committee members desirably will be a mix of public and private sector individuals, including academicians. The aim will be to keep abreast of latest developments in operations, design, benefits and costs. Included will be safety impacts and circulation impacts on vehicles, pedestrians and bicyclists. Another aspect is the different applications of roundabouts, namely, traffic control vs. traffic calming. Ultimately, it is hoped that the committee will participate in shaping policies, practices and standards.

Several activities are occurring both locally and dealing with this "hot" topic. Upcoming local section conferences will address roundabouts, plus there have been a number of national publications/activities, including the FHWA Roundabout Design Guide, new materials in the Highway Capacity Manual 2000 and activities of the National Committee on Uniform Traffic Control Devices. Some section members have related involvement through on-going project work.

Then plan on attending an initial formation/"brainstorming" meeting immediately after the April Illinois Section meeting (Thursday, April 19, 2001 at Maggiano's – Chicago). 
