As Director of Plan Development, Mr. Wies has had oversign of all stages of the Shared Path 2030 Plan for the Chicago Area Transportation Study (CATS). The Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) is updated every three years to fulfill Federal requirements for funding in our large metropolitan region. CATS is designated by the Illinois governor and locally elected officials as the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for northeastern Illinois, responsible for developing the RTP. The CATS' Policy Committee includes representatives of local governments and transportation planning agencies, and is responsible for RTP oversight and approval.

The Shared Path 2030 process began with a series of Planning Information Forums, starting in June, 2001, and running through May, 2002. These forums covered the broad range of issues necessary for input into a comprehensive Regional Transportation Plan, such as mobility and accessibility, land use, freight, financial forecasting, the natural environment, and management and operations. Concurrent with the Information Forums, individuals and groups have been able to submit proposals for regional transportation improvements for the 2030 Plan. As the RTP process has progressed, CATS staff and the Policy Committee have produced the corresponding planning documents. The recent public comment period for the final plan documents runs from August 1 to September 2, 2003.

Mr. Wies will be presenting an overview of the Shared Path 2030 process and highlights of ongoing and new projects that have resulted from the plan.
