ITE/WTS/ITS Midwest Autonomous Vehicle Luncheon

The Illinois Section of ITE was proud to co-host a luncheon panel event with ITS Midwest and WTS Greater Chicago Chapter on June 27th. The panel, moderated by **Ann Schlenker** of Argonne National Laboratory's Center for Transportation Research, focused on the opportunities and barriers for the future deployment of autonomous vehicles, particularly in Illinois. The panel included:

Rep. Michael Zalewski: Illinois State Representative from the 23rd District

Jerry Quandt: Executive Director from the Illinois Autonomous Vehicles Association

Aimee Lee: Senior Manager of Strategic Planning from the Illinois Tollway

Terry Heffron: ITS Unit Manager from IDOT's ITS Program Office

Our speakers discussed priorities, leadership opportunities, and the challenges ahead in terms of AV deployment. Representative Zalewski, who has sponsored two AV bills in the Illinois assembly, provided key insights as to how the Illinois legislature is working to tackle this constantly changing topic. Jerry, who has led ILAVA for its 18-month existence, described his organization's role in facilitating the conversations between the private vehicle manufacturing industry, the public sector (DOTs), and the legislative arm of government. Aimee and Terry both dove into what their agencies are doing to prepare, and what other agencies can look for as AV technologies and policies move forward.

In the years ahead, there are many questions which still need to be answered:

1. What will the vehicle ownership model look like when AV technology becomes more mainstream?
2. What kind of disruption will AV technology have on freight and mass transit?
3. What role does government play as things move forward? How much do states take on versus the federal government?
4. Will AV technologies deploy in an equitable fashion?

Technical Webinar: Work Zone Performance Management Webinar

On June 3, IL ITE hosted a webinar event at the DuPage County Division of Transportation. Ten attendees learned about Work Zone Performance Management, presented by the FHWA as part of its Smarter Work Zones program. The webinar covered the use of probe vehicle data, practices for mainstreaming performance management into agency policies and processes, and how to incorporate work zone managements into TSMO initiatives. Presenters included practitioner from Ohio and Virginia DOTs, as well as a representative from AASHTO. This webinar was attended by several members of the public sector, achieving ITE's initiative of ensuring that technical events are relevant to all types of transportation professionals.

Technical Webinar: Connected/Autonomous Vehicles & Active Transportation Webinar

This webinar took place at AECOM's Chicago office on June 20 and was attended by seven professionals. The presentation consisted of the variety of issues that must be considered when planning and designing for CAVs and active transportation, as well as safety benefits and risks related to the CAV-active transportation interface, identifying current multimodal safety and street design strategies that may be more or less relevant in the future, and understanding the concerns and desires from pedestrians sharing roads with autonomous vehicles. Legislative Corner

Governor J.B. Pritzker [signed](#) the \$45 billion [capital](#) spending plan, "Rebuild Illinois", back in June. Approximately \$33.2 billion will be set aside for [transportation](#) projects. Here's an [overview](#) of the projects in line to receive funding. CMAP has converted the [Public Act](#) into a [data table](#) that is now available for download.

Scooters have arrived in Chicago! The Chicago [e-scooter share pilot project](#) will run from June 15, 2019 to October 15, 2019. Take your pick of the [10 companies](#) that are part of the scooter pilot. [Divvy](#) will also begin adding 10,500 e-bikes to its fleet by 2021. Efforts to clarify where these "low-speed electric mobility devices" and "low-speed electric bicycles" are allowed have also shown up in legislation. See the City of Chicago [e-bike ordinance](#), which [passed](#) in April, and [House Bill 1590](#), currently in the Illinois Legislature. [Cities around the country](#) with e-bikes as part of the bikeshare system have already seen a jump in ridership - looks like these micromobility vehicles are here to stay.



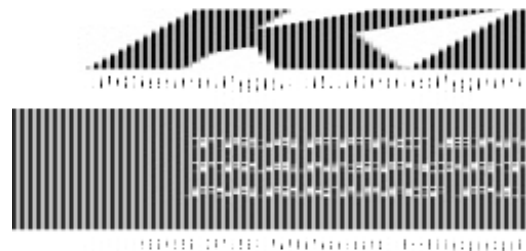

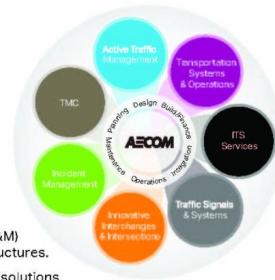
