#### **Ford Safety Insights Webinar**

On Tuesday, March 16th, the Illinois Section of ITE, in partnership with ITS Midwest, hosted the March luncheon featuring Andy Palanisamy and Cal Coplai from Ford Mobility as they presented information on their web-based tool, Ford Safety Insights.

Safety planning today is done after crashes have occurred, with out-of-date data that can be inaccessible or scattered across multiple systems. Ford Mobility wanted to create a platform to help transportation professionals streamline their traffic safety analysis and become more proactive, using all available data in a simple, single platform that utilizes industry standards to identify hotspots that need solutions and what those solutions should be.

Ford Safety Insights helps unlock more than just historical crash patterns with Ford's connected vehicle data. It provides insight into driver behavior, distracted driving, and treacherous road conditions. This data can help provide a more comprehensive picture of safety on your roadways. Safety planning can shift into the future, becoming proactive, identifying emerging hotspots of safety events before they manifest into many crashes.

#### Sad news regarding the passing of Gerald (Jerry) Charles Hoff

Jerry was a long-term member of ITE and the 1989 President of the Illinois Section ITE.

Jerry was born on August 31, 1938 in Waukegan, Illinois to Carl and Lillian (nee Andersen) Hoff. He died Tuesday, March 9, 2021 at his home. Jerry graduated from the University of Illinois with a BS in Civil Engineering and a MS in Urban Traffic and Transportation from Northwestern University. He began his career in public transportation in 1963 working at the Chicago Area Expressway Surveillance Project in Oak Park. Research projects included all phases of freeway operations relating to a central computerbased freeway data acquisition and control system. From 1971 to 1973, he worked for IDOT on their 5year highway program. He served on Gov. Ogilvie's RTA taskforce in 1974, developing service standards to be used by a regional public transportation authority. As Director of Program Development at the CTA, he was involved in creating many aspects of their capital improvement program such as grant preparation and methods of selecting capital projects. He ended his career at Metra as Department Head of General Development managing Metra's capital program for 14 years. Jerry was active in Arlington Heights, serving on the Planning Commission, and the Board of Local Improvements. He was President of the Surrey Ridge Homeowners Assoc. and helped plan the 4th of the July parade.

Yvonne and Jerry treasured their 20 years at their vacation home on Lake Wisconsin. Jerry often shared his appreciation of the beautiful landscape and interesting history of the Baraboo area with his family and friends.


