Recent Technical Event

- Members value networking opportunities and access to technical events the most. Similarly, these
 were the top two responses when members were asked what would motivate them to become
 more involved with ITE.
- Our membership is spread out geographically across Illinois, with a majority of members working and living in the Chicago Suburbs.
- Most members plan to return to in-person events now that Illinois is in Phase 5.
- Members are primarily looking for events focused on roadway/intersection design, traffic operations analysis and modeling, and transportation innovations.
- Our Annual Banquet is many member's favorite event!

Upcoming Events

In response to the membership survey we our holding our first in person event of the year on August 26th at Top Golf in Schaumberg.
