The evening was

The keynote was delivered by Jose Rios, Regional Engineer, District/Region One, Illinois Department of Transportation. The John LaPlante Past President's Award was given to Luann Hamilton (TranSmart) for her career achievements in urban transportation planning while at the Chicago Department of Transportation (CDOT). The outstanding Member Award was given to Karyn Robles for her tireless work as co-chair of the Activities Committee. The Outgoing President's Award was given to 2021 President Jenna Brose for her past year of service as Section President. The Student Paper and Scholarship awards were both awarded to Limon Barua a graduate student at UIC for his paper titled: *Modeling Household Online Shopping Demand in the U.S.: A Machine Learning Approach and Comparative Investigation between 2009 and 2017.* Over one thousand dollars was raised for the Section's student scholarship fund through several silent auctions and raffles held throughout the evening.

So far this year, I have the great opportunity to listen to ideas and new initiatives of the new Section Board as well as continue and advance initiatives of past years, such as the Public Agency Partnership and Mentor-Mentee programs initiated by previous boards. Student Scholarships

The Illinois Section was proud to be able to present scholarships during the pandemic which were formally announced at the Annual Banquet in April.

The award winner for the graduate scholarship was Limon Barua from the University of Illinois-Chicago (UIC). Limon will graduate in December 2022 with his PhD in Transportation with an emphasis in sustainable mobility and logistics. Limon was also selected for the Student Paper award for his paper

titled, "Modeling Household Online Shopping Demand in the U.S.: A Machine Learning Approach and Comparative Investigation between 2099 and 2017." The paper presents taking a machine learning approach for predicting household-level inline shopping demand, and for revealing the importance of influencing factors and their relationships with the demand. The models developed and insights gained can be used for online shopping-related freight demand generation and may also be considered for evaluating the potential impact on online shopping demand of relevant policies. Limon is an accomplished student and researcher who is the current president of the ITE UIC Student Chapter.

Student Chapter Report

We have two active student chapters from the 2021 – 2022 academic year (Illinois Institute of Technology (IIT) and the University of Illinois – Chicago (UIC)). The student chapters were active during the pandemic and included both in-person and virtual presentations. Topics that were presented included concepts on platooning, co-operative adaptive cruise control, vehicle speed optimization, statewide travel demand modeling, urban mobility management, and an introduction to Microstation. Students from IIT also attended the 2022 Transportation Research Board (TRB) annual meeting virtually to present their published papers and interact with other researchers. Overall, it has been a very productive year and we anticipate even more involvement for the 2022-2023 academic year. We are looking forward to engaging with the student chapters as we have more opportunities for in-person events to help grow and inspire the next generation of engineers.
