#### LeadershipITE Spotlight: Kristel Shu Bassett

IL ITE's **Kristel Shu Bassett**, P.E., PTOE recently finished the Leadership ITE program. We asked her to provide an update:

I'm tremendously fortunate to be a graduate of LeadershipITE (LITE), thanks to the support of Iteris, Inc. and to the Illinois Section and Great Lakes District of ITE.

My graduating class consisted of 23 transportation professionals from all over the US and Canada—with varying years of experience and expertise. The program began in January with in-person sessions in Washington, DC that coincided with the Transportation Research Board (TRB) annual meeting. We learned early on about our individual values, work style, and communication style, that serve as foundation for becoming effective communicators and empathic leaders.

For the next six months, we met virtually to hone our communication and presentation skills, managing change, handling difficult people and conversations, delegation, and more. During this time, we also worked in small groups for our capstone project with the guidance of an ITE staff liaison, an alumni mentor, and an ITE International Board of Direction (IBOD) mentor. The program concluded with inperson sessions on combating confirmation bias in the decision-making chain and finding a healthy work/life balance before officially graduating at the ITE International Annual Meeting.

While the program might be extensive and challenging, your time and effort will result in substantial rewards. The last eight months have been a period of personal and professional growth that will positively direct my career. My class and I continue to support each other after graduation—celebrating small wins and uplifting each other. On a similar note, I've noticed more introductions begin with "You were in Leadership? I was class of...!". ITE welcomed me into its community and equipped me with essential skills and a holistic toolkit to lead with competence, empathy, and integrity. I am privileged to be a part of this network, and I am excited to see where the future takes us.

Since graduating from UIC Masters in Urban Planning and Policy Program in the spring of 1994, **Benet Haller** has spent the past 30 years working in the Chicago area in a variety of planning endeavors. In the 1990s he worked at the Oak Park Housing Center and Teska Associates prior to joining the Chicago Planning Department in 1998. Over nearly 20 years with the City, Benet worked on the redevelopment of Cabrini-Green in the near north side, led planned development review and managed the development of neighborhood and city-wide plans. In late 2017, Benet started working for the Cook County Department of Transportation and Highways as Transit Manager and works extensively on both bike and transit projects and was the manager for both the recently published County Bike Plan and the County Transit Plan, scheduled to be published this year. He has a degree in history from the University of Chicago and has masters degrees in planning, architecture, and geography.

# **August 2023 Technical Webinar Parking Solutions for Livable Communities**

On July 18th, the Illinois Section of ITE was pleased to host a Technical Webinar on Parking Solutions for Livable Communities. The webinar was put on by Lindsay Bayley from CMAP and Jane Wilberding from HNTB.

As one of the largest single land uses in any community's "footprint", parking deserves more attention than is typically bestowed upon it. Besides encouraging the use of automobiles, having such a large supply of parking influences the character, form, function, and flow of our communities. At the same time, parking is necessary to support a community's local businesses; finding the right balance between supply

and demand—as an economics would—is the next step.

Lindsay and Jane informed the audience of just how to strike this balance while creating a more livable and vibrant community. They provided a brief history of the issues associated with how parking policies have been implemented in the past, explained the adverse effects they have on cities, celebrate the substantial momentum for reforming them, and discussed opportunities for our City and region.
